Fashion designer turned artist Nicole Farhi has her largest exhibition to date currently running at Beaux Arts Gallery. Folds focuses on the beauty of the female body, particularly when folds of flesh form shapes and curves. It includes pieces modelled by Sue Tilley, who previously posed for works by Lucian Freud.
